History

Danube International School Vienna was founded in 1992 and now resides in an elegant building in the centre of Vienna near the Prater park and Danube canal. The school delivers an international education for students from Early Years until Grade 12 and school enrolment is currently 540 with 43 in Grade 12.

Community

DISV is international in its student body with 60 nationalities on role. Students from Austria account for 28% of enrolment with other significant groupings being Russian 16%, British 6%, German 6% and American 4%.

Academic Program

DISV provides a college preparatory program with English as the language of instruction. Graduates earn a High School Diploma and almost all students pursue the full IB Diploma program in Grades 11 and 12, a few students will complete IB courses only. All students complete the IB Middle Years program in Grades 9 and 10. The IB Diploma program is a demanding pre-university course of study that leads to external examinations. In total 35 IB courses are offered, with additional courses undertaken in mother tongue languages.

The School Faculty

The culturally diverse, qualified and experienced faculty is drawn from 20 different countries.

High School Organisation

The school year consists of two semesters of 18 weeks (August – January, January – June) for a total of 175 school days. There are eight 40 minute periods per day, with an additional period for IB Diploma students.
